Lieutenant Colonel Robyn L. Pietron, a native of Howell, Michigan, graduated from Central Michigan University in 1995 and was commissioned in the United States Army Signal Corps. Her first duty assignment after completion of the Signal Officers Basic Course was Fort Huachuca, Arizona with the 40th Signal BN where she served as a Platoon Leader, Battalion S1 and a Company Commander. She was selected for Command in Saudi Arabia where she served for two years, 2000-2002. LTC Pietron then moved to Fort Carson, Colorado serving as a S6 and an assignment within the Space and Missile Defense Command. Additional follow on assignments include Operations Officer with the Center for Army Lessons Learned and Cyber Security work with the Office of the Secretary of Defense writing a CONOP for the COCOM Commanders. LTC Pietron has been deployed three times, the most recent to Afghanistan with the 25th Signal Battalion, serving as the Battalion Executive Officer.

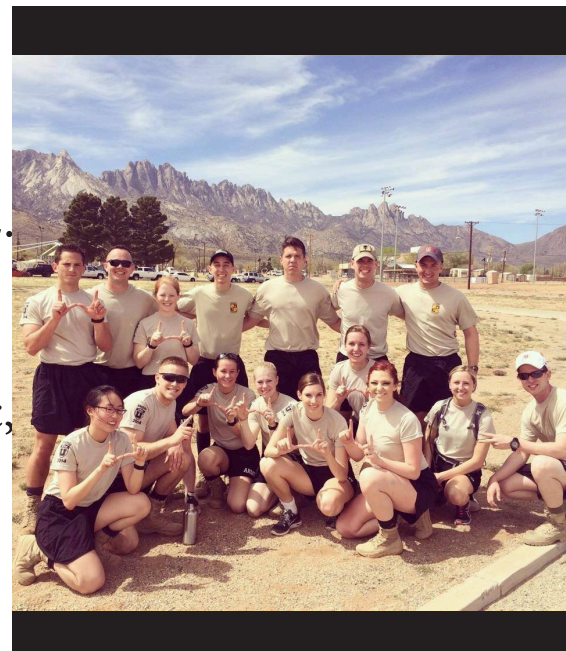
